### *Starters & Nibbles & Things to Share*

<b>Stir Fried Squid with Chorizo &amp; Padron Peppers</b>	<b>£8</b>
<b>Provençal Fish Soup</b> – smooth and creamy, with rouille, cheese and toasts	<b>£7</b>
<b>Smoked Haddock, Trout and Basil Creamy Gratin</b> – a ramekin of bubbling flavour, served with crust bread and dressed green leaves	<b>£6</b>
<b>6 Dorset Snails</b> – with warm bread	<b>£6</b>

### *Mains*

<b>Duck and Blackberry Salad</b> - pan fried duck breast seasoned with rose pepper, and carved onto a salad of leaves, blackberries, mint and chilli, dressed with blackberry vinaigrette	<b>£12.50</b>
<b>Fresh Lowestoft Cod in Beer Batter</b> – with chips and peas and tartare sauce or with a Pesto Crust, Roast Cherry tomatoes and some skinny fries	<b>£11</b> <b>£13</b>
<b>Thai Green Pheasant Curry</b> – with sticky rice.... The Pheasant hails from the East and makes a delicious alternative to chicken in this classic favourite...	<b>£12</b>
<b>Butternut Squash &amp; Wild Mushroom Risotto</b> – don't think we can get any more seasonal than that...	<b>£12</b>
